HOW TO FIND US - STARTING YOUR HOLIDAY

Using our postcode SA43 3BJ brings you almost to the door, or our what3words is:
///essential.encounter.different.

From the North, carry on the A487 after Cardigan toward Fishguard for around two miles. If approaching from the M4, take the A48 to Carmarthen, then please see the next page for best routes from there.

Look for a sign off the A487 to Moylegrove (Trewyddel in Welsh). Proceed for around one mile, straight over a junction, and Trenwydd Farm is on your left hand side. Look out for cheerful coloured cottages, our slate sign at the entrance, and our welcome sign just for you!

On arrival, there's a check-in spot to stop in, and you will see the Reception sign on the main Farmhouse at the head of the driveway. We will normally be on site, and will probably see you arrive and come out to greet you. If not, go to the Reception door and press the Ring doorbell to alert us that you are here.

You are welcome to park your car outside your cottage to unload, then please move it to a parking spot in the car park (or as directed in the winter months) unless you are using the EV charger, in which case park next to the charge point in front of the barn.

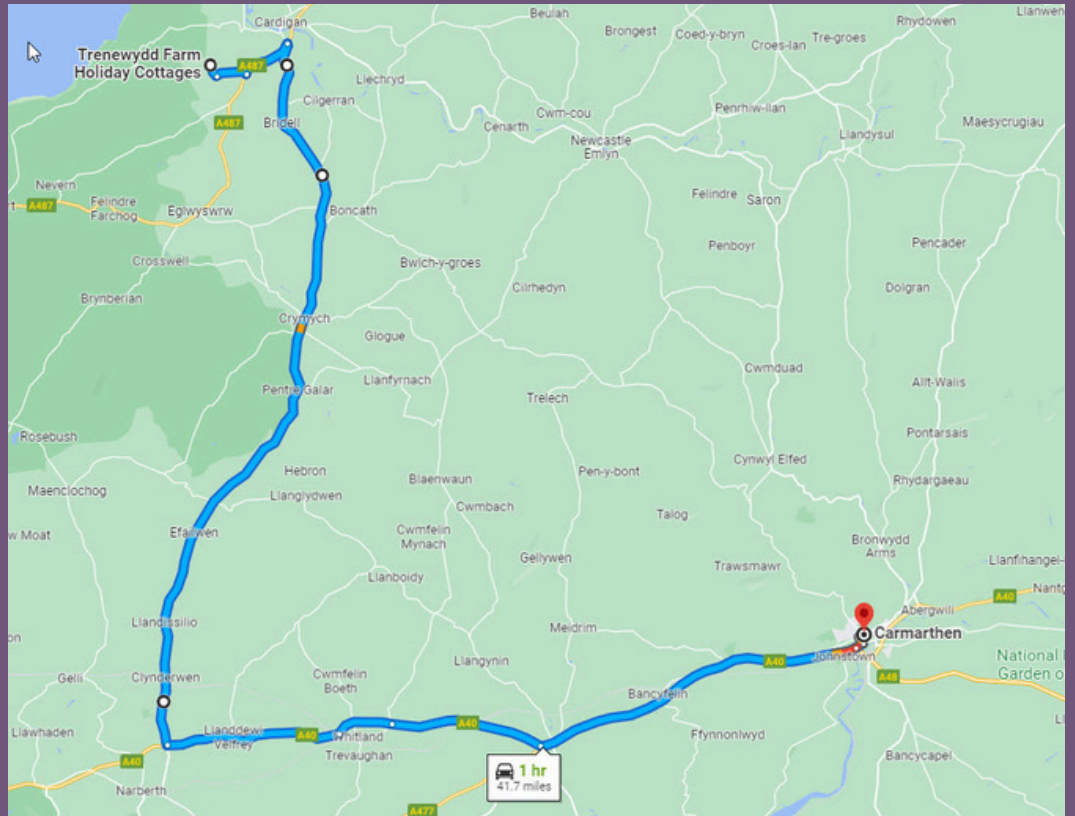

Our Suggested Routes

Route one

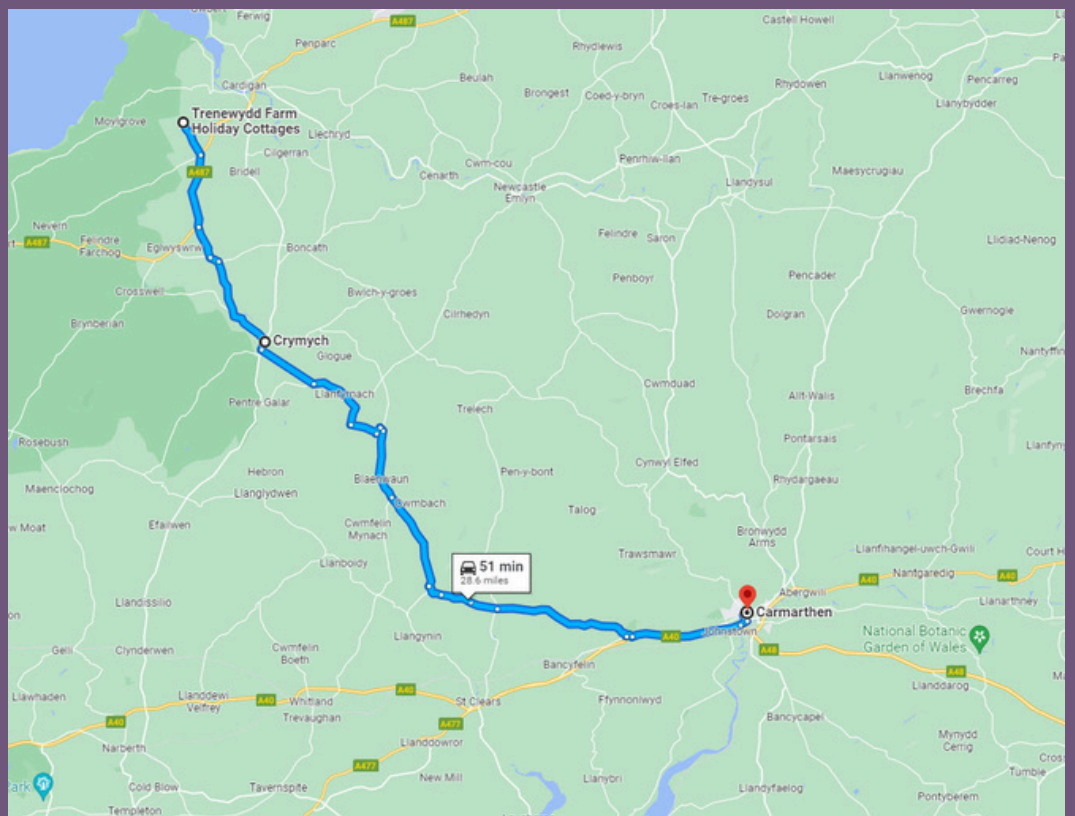
If you don't know the area well, all three of these routes look similar on the map, and have similar travel times. However, if you want to get to us as quickly as possible, with the best roads and the least amount of twists and turns then we strongly suggest Route one.

On the A40, follow signs for Haverfordwest and Fishguard until the big Narberth roundabout, where you'll see the first sign to Cardigan, fourth exit.



Route two

Your sat nav will likely suggest Route two, but this does have more of the smaller roads with lots of winding bends and we wouldn't recommend this option.



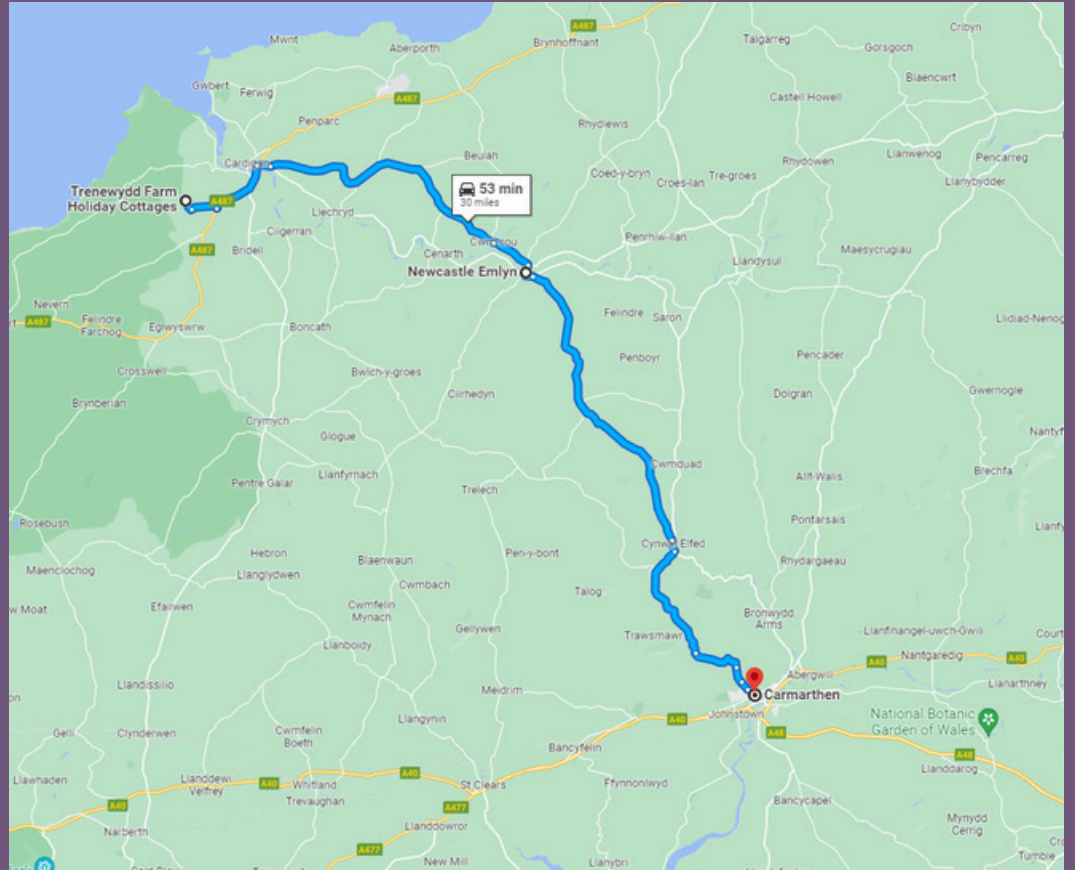

Route three

Route three works if you're not in a hurry and want the best scenery to enjoy on your way.

This lovely route takes you through the quaint town of Newcastle Emlyn and the fabulous Cenarth Falls.

What We Offer

SWIMMING POOL

Our swimming pool is normally open between May and September and is available for use at most times, including in the evening when it is lit up. If the weather is particularly warm before May or after September, we will open the pool for use but of course this cannot be guaranteed in advance.

The pool is solar heated, supplemented with an air source heat pump which keeps the temperature at around 26-28 degrees. At the beginning and at the end of the season the water may not be at the optimum temperature if the weather is quite cold. The combination of solar energy and air source heat pump is very effective as long as the ambient temperature doesn't cool the water down as fast as we heat it. People sometimes bring wetsuits, which you may like to consider if your booking is at either end of the summer and you definitely want to use the pool during your stay.

You will be asked to sign a consent form to use the pool on arrival, and other safety guidelines are in your Guest Information book in your cottage.

FOOTGOLF COURSE

We have a nine-hole FootGolf course, which is open from April to October. As guests, you are welcome to play at any time with no extra charge. It's great fun, open to all ages and abilities, and can get quite competitive!

SLOT CAR SHACK

There is a digital scalextric track layout in our slot car shack, where up to five people can race cars around the circuit. The technology includes a lap counter, fastest lap, etc... so you can have a proper Grand Prix competition! This is an hour-long event, run in the evenings at 7pm, 8pm or 9pm, and it's £20 for the session (to cover our time and any damages). It's great fun, with music and lights etc, so do have a go.

PLAYING FIELD

You are welcome to play ball games on our playing field. There are football nets, and you may wish to bring badminton or similar equipment. We also have an outdoor table tennis table and giant chess set.

GYM

We have a small indoor area with a treadmill and elliptical trainer, which you are welcome to use.

PREMISES LICENCE

We stock locally produced beers and ciders, as well as wine, champagne, and prosecco which adults can buy from Reception between 10am and 10pm.

BIKE RACK

Trenwydd Farm sits directly on sustrans cycle route 82, so don't forget your bikes! You are welcome to lock them up overnight on the bike rack in our large barn, which is under cover.

BOARD GAMES

There's no better time to sit with the family and have some competitive fun. We have a selection of games available, just peruse the list in your cottage and let us know what you'd like to borrow.

OTHER INFORMATION

GROCERY DELIVERIES

Tesco deliver to us, so you may want to think about arranging a grocery delivery for your arrival. If you do, please just let us know so that we can direct the driver, and/or put everything in your cottage if you have been held up.

CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT

Check in is after 3pm, and check out is by 10am.

BOOK AHEAD

If you'd like any suggestions of what you might like to do while you're here, or where to eat, we are happy to advise. You might like to book ahead, as places do get busy particularly in the high season.

ACCESSIBILITY

Oak Cottage and Maple Cottage have staircases, and stairgates are provided in these cottages. Cherry Cottage and Cosy Cottage have two steps internally. Ash Cottage has no steps internally, unless interlinked with Oak Cottage. Chestnut Cottage has no steps internally; there are steps leading to the front door, but ramp access is available at the rear patio doors on request.

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

Your cottage is fully furnished and beds are made up, so you don't need to bring bedding, linen, or hand/bath towels. Do remember to bring pool/beach towels though. We have a travel cot and highchair, which can be moved into your cottage if available; please do ask if you need them.

Your kitchen is well equipped with a dishwasher, washing machine/ dryer, fridge freezer, cooker and microwave oven. There is also crockery (including plastic child-friendly), cutlery, glassware, utensils, cooking equipment, toaster, kettle, vacuum cleaner, clothes airer, iron and ironing board, and a hairdryer. There is a cafetière, as well as a Nescafé Dolcé Gusto coffee machine if you want to bring pods for that, although we do sell them in Reception. If you arrive and find that it would have been useful to have something added to this list, please do let us know!
